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## SAT Math Prep Class with Geneva teacher, Pam Warren

One major component of this SAT prep course is the "Ten Commandments of SAT Math." Knowing these can make or break a student's math score on the SAT. Instead of allowing themselves to be defeated by tricky questions, students will approach the SAT with confidence on test day. During this class, Mrs. Warren will not only cover basic categories of SAT math questions, but she will also allow students to choose which topics to work on and will provide them with focused instruction in that area. Most students will improve math scores by at least 100 points. This class is open to any 9th-12th grade student and will be held at Geneva Academy, August 22-25, 10:00-12:00.
