A Summary of Tuition and Tuition Assistance at Geneva

Geneva Academy has always provided Tuition Assistance to families. It is made possible by donations to Geneva Academy for that purpose. The school distributes 100% of those charitable gifts to families that apply for financial help.

Accessing Regular Tuition Assistance (TA)

Families complete the admissions pages first, then **apply online** for Tuition Assistance. There is a \$35 charge for applying. When TA is granted, families are asked to complete an additional 25 service hours. **Regular Tuition Assistance awards are usually 20-30% off tuition**. Assistance is awarded by need, not by merit (grades), though completion of service hours and involvement at the school may be a factor in the following year's award. Note: there are currently no set restrictions on the number of families given TA awards. Total TA is restricted, however, by the level of donations received by the school.

Accessing Expanded Tuition Assistance (ETA)

Families complete the admissions process first, then apply via paper form for Expanded Tuition Assistance. There is a \$35 charge for applying. When ETA is granted, families are asked to commit to a much more significant service obligation (suitable to a family's schedule, skillsets, etc.) which may exceed 100 hours in a calendar year. **Expanded Tuition Assistance awards may be up to 90% off tuition.** A pastoral reference is also required. Assistance is awarded by need, not by merit (grades), though completion of service hours and involvement at the school may be a factor in the following year's award as well as the extension of the ETA program. Note: there are limits in each grade as to the number of ETA slots provided.

The chart below shows regular tuition for 2024-25 for different grade levels. Full-paying families are charged the amount in the "Total Per Year" column, normally paid in 1, 10, or 12 installments. Examples of tuition payments when granted either Tuition Assistance or Expanded Tuition Assistance are in the adjacent columns.
